
### AN UPDATE FROM SHERIFF MIKE WILLIAMS:

The ShotSpotter® technology rolled out in 2017 and is installed in the Northwest part of the city. It is designed to detect gunfire and provide law enforcement with a precise location of the shots that were fired. This technology can also determine the number of shots within a certain radius.

Benefits include, but are not limited to:

- an expedited response to help shooting victims;
- proactive gun crime pattern analysis and strategic deterrence;
- an enhanced situational awareness and officer safety;
- and is a cost-effective force multiplier



This state-of-the-art technology brings various data into one central location for enhanced analysis. It is utilized by police departments throughout the United States and it helps provide a situational awareness for law enforcement.

The Real Time Crime Center will be a force multiplier for Jacksonville. This advanced technology provides mapping, surveillance videos, and also builds on programs such as the Computer Aided Dispatch and ShotSpotter® alerts. Now we won't just have the alert, we will be able to see what transpired moments before and after thanks to the video.




